<u>CGW4U ISU Stage 6 – Seminar Presentation</u>

Task:

You will prepare and deliver a creative presentation of your independent study topic and argument, through visual and/or performance art.

Method:

- 1. Your presentation shall comprise no more than 20 minutes of a class period.
- 2. Your presentation will incorporate in a meaningful way the following information:
 - i. The background information of the topic you chose
 - ii. Information related to the 2 sides of the issue
 - iii. How the issue can be analyzed according to 2 factors within geography (economic, political, social, globalization...)
- 3. You can choose from a variety of delivery methods. Some **possible** ideas include:
 - A. **Video** create your own to deliver an aspect of your topic/argument, or use an existing movie, documentary, or clip that is connected to your topic and is appropriate for your presentation. Make sure to source this video properly in your works cited and during your presentation.
 - B. **Drama** monologues in character, using costume; short scenes, either live or recorded; "Hotseat" improvisation, where you answer questions from the group in character
 - C. **Music** PowerPoint with relevant soundtrack of cultural music to reinforce ideas; listening activity where you expose the group to cultural music and discuss meaning and context; performance of original songs inspired by your topic
 - D. **Dance** show recordings of cultural dance, explain meaning and relevance to topic; perform dance, live or recorded, that speaks to your topic, be prepared to explain your interpretation
 - E. **Visual Art** design and display a series of posters / pamphlets (3-4) whose purpose is to inspire action (social awareness, propaganda); design a Web site that promotes awareness of your issue; create a graphic novel / comic that teaches about your issue; collect and arrange a series of political cartoons about your issue, and analyze them for the group.
 - F. Your own idea see teacher for advice and approval
- 4. Class participation is necessary. Therefore, you must include some discussion questions that the group can engage in. Some of these questions will be included on the final evaluation.

B.	You will be able to sign up	via random draw.

- C. Once you have signed-up for a date, it cannot be changed if you do not present on the date that you are signed up for you will receive an incomplete mark for your presentation.
