Plan ahead by encouraging your child to...

GRADE 7 & 8

Investigate their interests and passions inside and outside of school

Use MyBlueprint to start their secondary school education plan

Attend Grade 8 Information
Nights to consult with
teachers and counsellors

GRADE 9

Enroll in courses that align with their interests, skills and academic abilities

Review and update their education plan on MyBlueprint

Consult with guidance counsellors to ensure they have the pre-requisite courses

GRADE 10

Explore opportunities in the Career Studies Course

Use MyBlueprint to align their post-secondary plans with their current secondary school education plan

Sign-up for the SHSM program & consult with SHSM Lead Teacher, or Guidance before grade 11 course selection
